Presidio

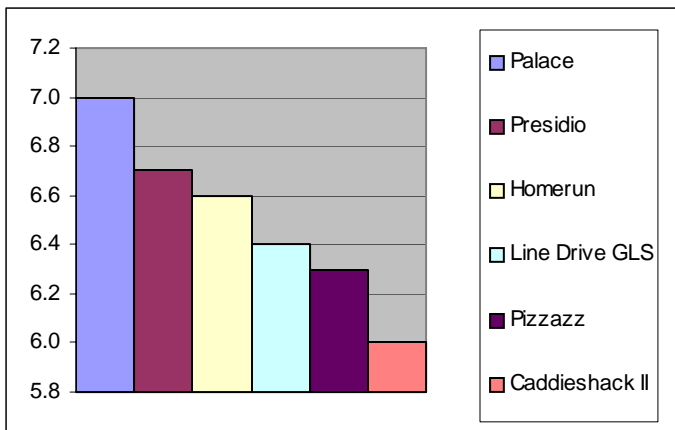

CHARACTERISTICS

Presidio has a very dark green genetic color and forms a dense, attractive turf. This variety is particularly adapted to the Mid-Atlantic region which has hot humid summers and cold extended winter conditions. Presidio contains germplasm that has been screened for resistance to Brown Patch, Pythium, Red Thread and Leafspot diseases.

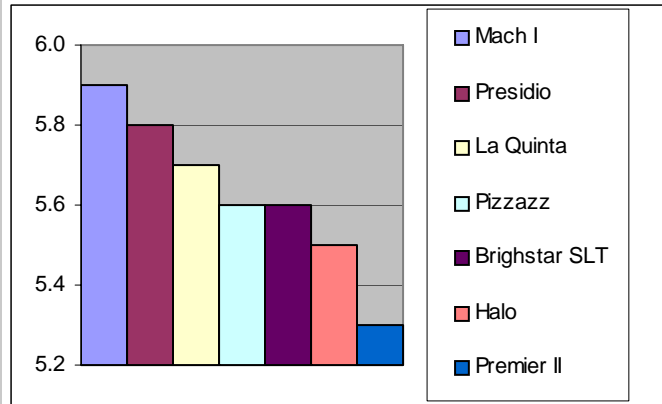
Parent lines have been incorporated into Presidio that have winter hardiness and resistance to snow mold. Presidio has exhibited excellent seedling vigor and rapidly forms a high quality turf. Presidio is endophyte enhanced for resistance to stress caused by specific insect pests.
