

EDGEWOOD is new dense strong creeping red fescue variety. It is an excellent replacement for Pennlawn, common or other vigorous creeping red fescue varieties. EDGEWOOD has an improved deeper green color. It is vigorous to germinate and has an improved establishment time frame.. EDGEWOOD has a low fertility requirement, so it is recommended in mixtures with other cool season grasses for low maintenance ground cover. It prefers less maintenance in regards to fertility than Kentucky bluegrass or perennial ryegrass, requiring half or less the fertilizer of rye and blue or tall fescue to persist.

EDGEWOOD is a very good turf performer in low maintenance, low traffic and shady conditions in cold and snow covered winter climates. It can be used successfully in shady conditions in warmer transition zone climates where turf type tall fescues are prevalent. EDGEWOOD strong creeping red fescue has moderate size leaves and an improved green color and persistence.

EDGEWOOD mixes well with turf type tall fescue, perennial ryegrass, and Kentucky bluegrass or other fine fescue species. When mixed with Kentucky bluegrass and perennial ryegrass, the mix becomes the ultimate seed formula for a sun or shady lawn. It performs well in medium to heavily shaded areas.
