

Alsike Clover

Trifolium hybridum



Alsike clover is an extremely winter hardy perennial clover. It is a palatable, short-lived perennial, lasting 2-3 years. However, it does well on low, poorly drained acid soils, and is suited to poor climates and wet soils. It will even tolerate some flooding for longer periods of time, where alfalfa and red clover would not. It may be killed out if drought periods become prolonged. Alsike is very palatable to all grazing animals and is often used in mixtures for hay or pasture.
